




To get started with the Club ELD app¹, make sure that:

- you are logged in to the system via your personal user ID and user password;
- your device is connected to a charger and the Bluetooth is turned on;
- your device is placed on a dashboard so that the DOT inspector has a full view of its screen without entering a truck.




For a Driver:


- 1 Tap the "DOT Inspect" icon to open an inspection menu.
- 2 Pass the device to the roadside inspector.

For an Inspector:


- 1 Choose the date to be inspected using a calendar to see all the data regarding a vehicle, driver, and carrier recorded by the ELD for the date you selected. Graphs depict the status changes and the table shows details for each event.
- 2 Tap the "**Start Inspection**" button to launch the inspection process.



To send the data to safety officials you need to tap **"Transfer Data to the Roadside Inspector"**.



Here you will see the list of all the co-drivers operating the same truck during the last 8 days period.



After that, you will see 3 data transferring options to choose from:

- Web Services (FMCSA);
- FMCSA email;
- Personal email (provided by the roadside inspector).
